Maintenance of Open Spaces at Earlsfield

The land actually belongs to a company in London, not the parish. The company refuses to do anything about maintenance or grass cutting, so the parish council stepped in last year to prevent an eyesore.

Obviously, the money that we get from council tax can only go so far, we are a small parish.

We took the decision that the parish could only afford 3 cuts this year.

If the company would pass the open spaces onto the parish council, we could, for example, put up swings etc, and raise money from the precept for grass cutting.

Please help by asking the County and District Councillors to put pressure on the holding company to face up to their responsibilities.
